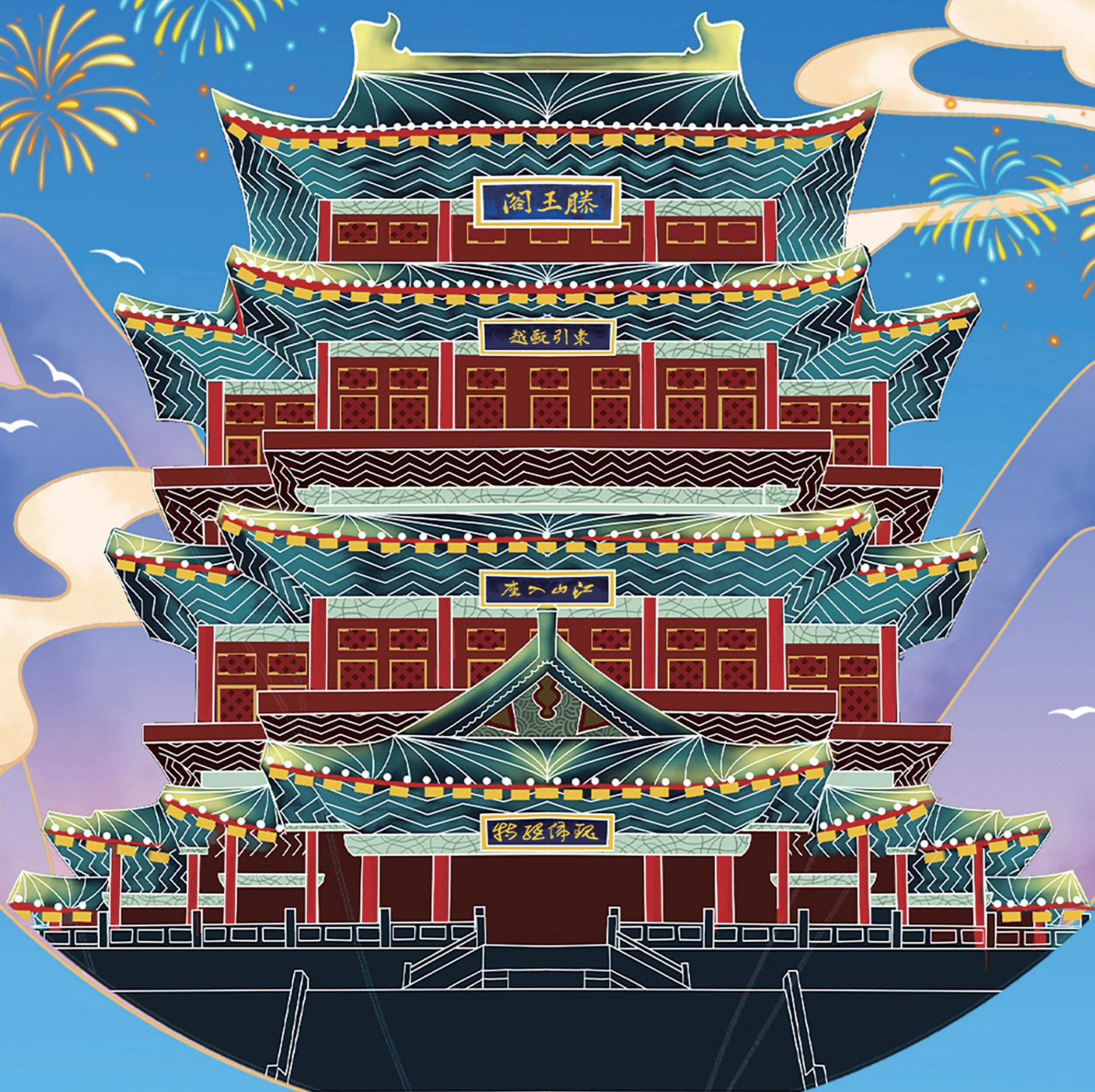

About JUFÉ »»

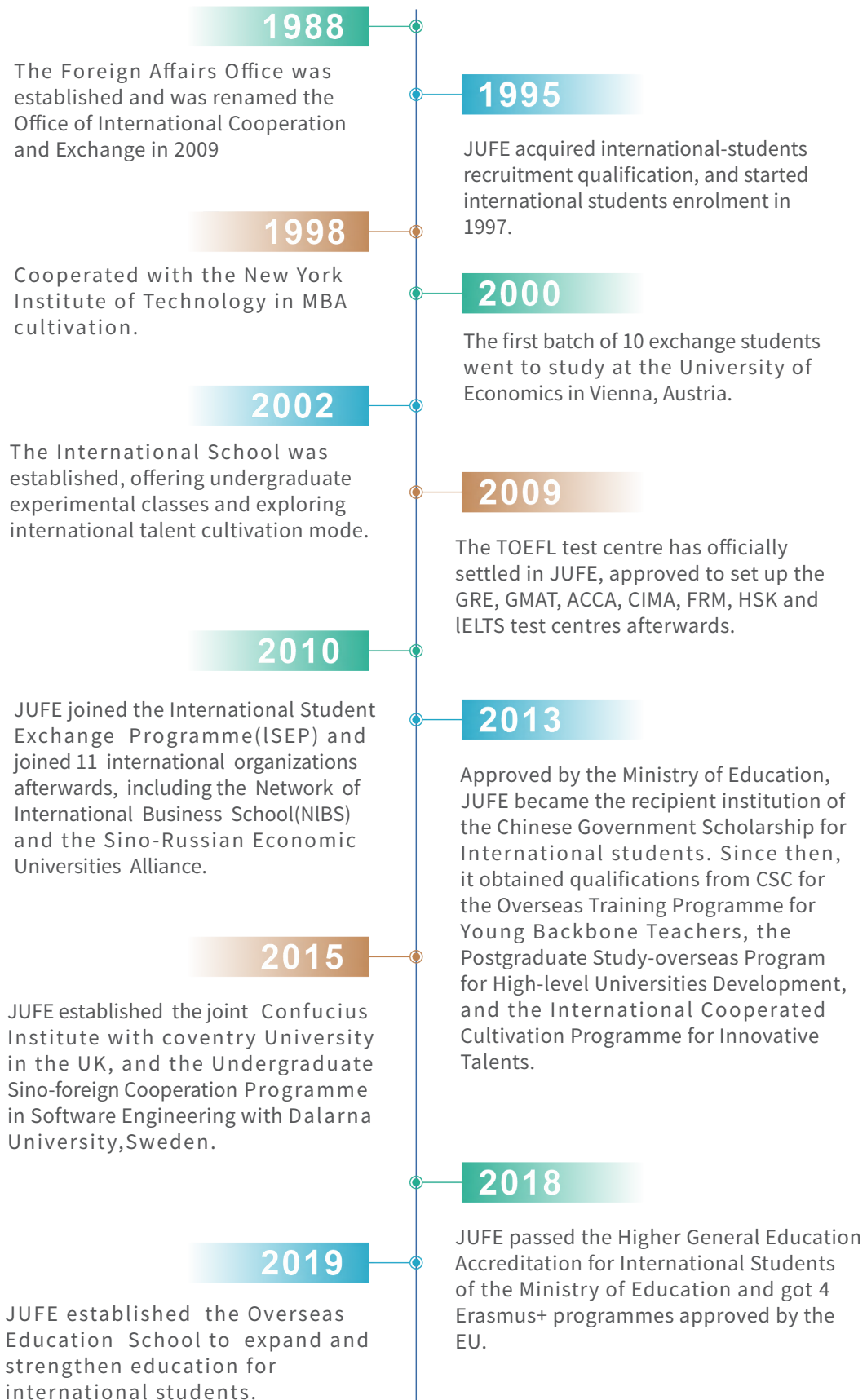

Duration: July 5--July 16

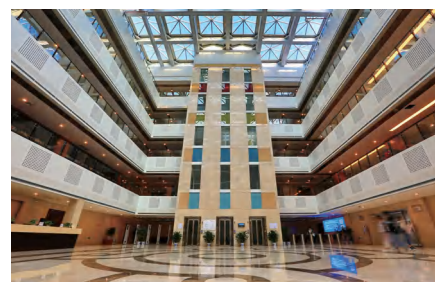
Organizer: School of Statistics and Data Science

I. Project Objectives

JUFE will send official invitation letters to successfully selected participants **around April 30, 2026.**

Step6

Participants will be matched with Chinese volunteers online **around May, 2026.**

Step7

An online orientation will be conducted by JUFE **around May 30, 2026.**

Step8

Relevant arrival and departure information for Nanchang need to submit **before 15 June, 2026.**



Required Application Documents

- 1.ID photo with a white background **(Required for both program)**
2. Photocopy of the passport's front page(PDF Version) **(Required for both program)**
- 3.HSK Certificate (Candidates with an HSK certificate will be given priority in the admission process.) **(Required for Program A&B&E&F)**
- 4.Student status certificate or academic transcript (PDF version, with official university seal); **(Required for Program B)**
- 5.Personal statement (within 1,000 words, explaining the motivation and expectations for participating in the project).**(Required for Program B)**

Visas and Insurance

Visa

Accepted students can apply for an appropriate visa(both “Visiting F” and “Tourist L” visas are acceptable)from their local Chinese embassy or consulate.

Insurance

According to the policy of China's Ministry of Education, international students must have medical and accident insurance while studying in China. Evidence of an insurance policy(purchased abroad and lasting the duration of each student's complete stay in China) must be provided upon registration.

While most visits will be free of ailments/ injuries, in the remote case something does happen it is important to understand that Chinese healthcare is NOT free. Having insurance avoid excessive costs and inconveniences.

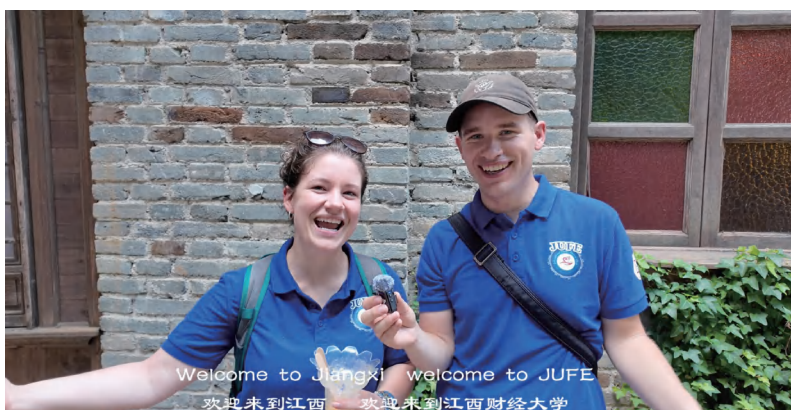

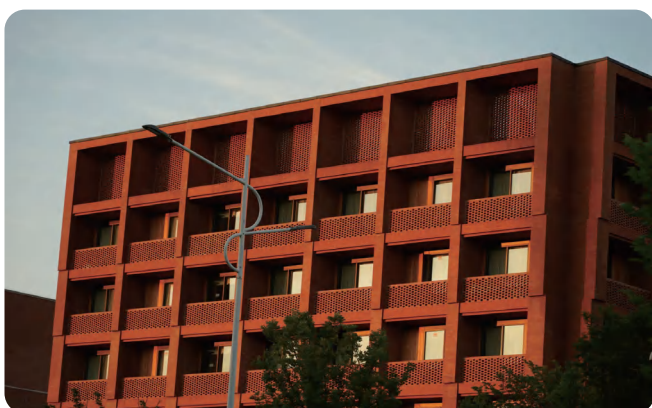
